



WORKSHOP REPORT

“ALEXANDRU ȘTEFULESCU” SECONDARY SCHOOL, TÂRGU-JIU, ROMANIA

Between 4th to 8th November 2019, the transnational project meeting within the project Erasmus+, ”CONSCIOUS TECHNOLOGY FOR THE FUTURE”, took place at “Alexandru Ștefulescu” Secondary School, in Târgu-Jiu, Romania.

The meeting was attended by 27 teachers from the partner countries, as follows: 6 from Bulgaria, 5 from Italy, 4 from Poland and 11 from Turkey.

The main theme of the meeting was safe internet usage and it was intended to increase the competences of participating school teachers for secure internet usage. To verify the achievement of this purpose, before the transnational project meeting, a pre-test was applied to measure the participants' awareness and knowledge levels regarding secure internet and after a post-test was conducted to evaluate participants' awareness and knowledge levels regarding secure internet.

Having as objectives the familiarization with some techniques for safe Internet usage by students, both during the didactic activity and outside the school, under the parents' supervision, “Alexandru Ștefulescu” Secondary School organized activities as follows:

- on Monday, 4th November 2019, training of participant teachers on safe Internet use and a presentation of a short movie about the negative impact of unsafe use of technology by our partner - County Police Inspectorate;
- on Wednesday, 6th November 2019 and on Thursday, 7th November 2019, the workshop for the preparation of handbooks for students about safe internet usage, workshop for the preparation of handbooks for parents about safe internet usage, workshop for the preparation of the handbooks for students who are involved in safe internet use and a teachers seminar on the informed use of internet in education.

The guests and at the same time the project partners of the Romanian team carried out an activity within they presented information about Malware Attacks Detection, offering ways to online use without jeopardizing the information stored in the computer. There were also presented ways through which the teachers and parents can guide the students to use the Internet without being subjected to aggression or endangering their personal identification data and thus becoming victims.

The second objective of the activities carried out between 4th to 8th November 2019, within the project Erasmus+, ”CONSCIOUS TECHNOLOGY FOR THE FUTURE”, was organizing a workshop on using WEB2 tools during the teaching process.

In this regard, the following activities were held out:

- On Monday, 4th November 2019, attending a lesson on ”Technology in literature”, using Socrative platform;



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- On Tuesday, 5th November 2019, attending an activity on "Creating online poems", using web tools and attending the activity "Technology's advocates versus outdoor life's advocates";
- On Wednesday, 6th November 2019, attending a biology lesson using the IWB;
- On Thursday, 7th November 2019, attending a maths lesson using digital devices for primary school pupils and electronic portfolio, alternative assessment methods made by means of WEB tools.

The conclusion of the participant teachers at the transnational meeting was that the use of the Internet in education adds value if it is used effectively and offers safety to both students and teachers.

The results of the post-test applied at the end of the activities highlighted the fact that the objectives proposed by the Romanian project team were achieved, the teachers from the partner countries proving improvement of the knowledge about the safe Internet usage.



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
